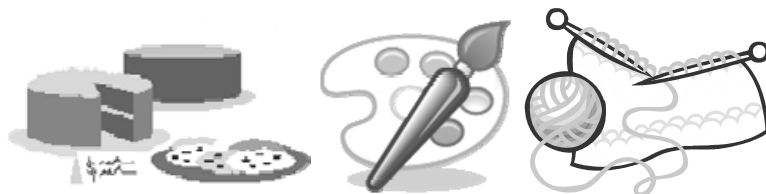


BUSHY PARK SHOW 2019



HOME INDUSTRIES SCHEDULE & ENTRY FORM

SATURDAY 16th FEBRUARY

Showground, Gordon River Rd, Bushy Park

Entries strictly close 9.30am Show Day.

**Deliver to competition area from 8am on Sat.16th Feb
OR between 11.00am and 7pm, Friday 15th Feb if possible.
OR contact us regarding prior arrangement with Committee member to collect.**

**1-4entries in Home Industries no fee if producer attending Show *
A fee of \$1 per entry applies thereafter to adult entries, junior 50c.**

***If not personally attending (others delivering/collection by committee member is required)
then fee of \$1 per entry applies to all items entered. Junior 50c.**

**Junior Section is for children aged from under 6 years through to and
including 16 year olds.**

Entries must have your name, section/class number clearly attached to each item. Name will be removed or covered with your exhibitor number by the steward before display and judging.

**Please do not submit any item that has previously been shown
at the Bushy Park Show.**

Hall of Industries – turn right once through the main gate.

SECTION A – Cooking

- Class **A1.** Plain cake iced
A2. Chocolate cake iced
A3. Cupcakes (3) decorated
A4. Special Occasion Cake (iced/decorated) eg. birthday, wedding
A5. Scones (3) plain
A6. Fruitcake un-iced
A7. Biscuits (3) eg. Anzacs, kiss etc
A8. Slice (3) cooked or uncooked
A9. Confectionary (3) eg. fudge, toffee, coconut ice
A10. Lamingtons (3)

Please note **no cream filling** for any cakes. Entries are preferably on a white plastic plate or tray and covered with gladwrap/similar or in a clear display container.

SECTION B – Flowers, Veges & Fruits

- Class **B11.** Most original floral display (fresh or fake)
Class **B12.** Most original idea using fruit and /or vegetables

SECTION C – Art, Crafts & Photography

- Class **C13.** Your artistic interpretation of the Derwent Valley past or present in any medium – eg. painting, drawing, photo, woodwork, pottery, papier mache etc

SECTION D – Knitting & Crochet

- Class **D14.** Knitted piece of clothing small
D14a. Knitted piece of clothing big
D15. Knitted other (e.g. toys, tea cosy etc)
D16. Crocheted piece of clothing small
D16a Crocheted piece of clothing big
D17. Crocheted other (e.g. toys, tea cosy etc)

Can be made from Sheep, Acrylic, Alpaca or any other natural fibre.

SECTION E – Needlework/Sewing

EMBROIDERY, QUILTING & PATCHWORK

- Class **E18.** Home Décor Items (e.g. tablecloths, cushions, runners etc)
E19. Clothing or toys

CROSS STITCH OR LONG STITCH

- Class **E20.** Home Décor Items (e.g., tablecloths, cushions, runners etc)
E21. Scene/picture

SEWING/DRESSMAKING

- Class **E22.** Clothing (dress, top, apron etc)
- E23.** Any other item (cushions etc)
- E24.** Sewn toy

HANDCRAFT

- Class **E25.** Decorated card
- E26.** Scrap booking
