Conditions of entry:

- Classes will not be held over for entrants in more than one ring.
- One group of led and ridden classes per horse/rider combination. e.g horse can do two groups of ridden classes but must be with two different riders
- Cruelty will not be tolerated.
- Handlers must wear appropriate footwear, and riders must wear an approved helmet, and appropriate footwear.
- Judges decision is final.
- Horses not to be left unattended tied to floats.
- State-bred and owned* – sire and dam to have been domiciled in Tasmania at time of breeding, foal born in Tasmania, and owned by a Tasmanian resident.
- Intermediate* - horses and riders who have not both competed at an “open” EA or SHC event in the previous 12 months.
- First Independent Walk/(Trot optional)* – Rider off Leading Rein with parent in attendance (Walking/running beside them).
- Novice – Horses and/or riders who have not won a “novice” class at any agricultural, breed or other horse show
- Classes may be split/combined at discretion of the show committee.
- Horse’s ages are calculated as at the 1st August each year.
- All Foals must be led and in control at all times.
- Colts and stallions must be handled by a competent person 18 years or over.
- The committee reserves the right to demand that any unruly, diseased, or dangerous exhibit leave the ground.
- The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program
- Non-participation in an event will not warrant a refund of any monies. Entry monies may be refunded at the committee’s discretion if a Veterinary Certificate and/or Doctor’s Certificate accompany the request within 7 days from the shows date
- Ribbons will be awarded to 4th place.

1. Acknowledges, agrees and represents that he/she further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he/she feels anything to be unsafe, he/she will immediately advise the officials of such and refuse to participate further in the EVENT(S).

2. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the club/coach, participants, EA and its state bodies or any subdivision thereof, officials, volunteers, medical personnel, any persons, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the EVENT(S), premises and event inspectors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT(S) and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, all for the purposes as herein referred to as "Releasees", FROM ALL LIABILITY, TO THE UNDERSIGNED, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OR RELATED TO THE EVENT(S), WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
